

SBBA ANNUAL MEETING

The 2010 Annual Spanish Barb Breeders Assoc. meeting will be held September 16-19, 2010. The location is once again, the Burro Mountain Homestead, a lovely, privately owned, camper ranch nestled high in the pine trees, surrounded by the Gila National Forest. BMH is 18 miles from Silver City, New Mexico. The weather here will be beautiful this time of the year, average temperatures are highs in the low 80's & lows in the mid 50's.

Some of the MEALS will be provided by Master Camp Cook & SBBA board member, Mike Bruce. Mike will be fixing breakfast for all on Friday and Saturday mornings. He will also be providing Chicken and Brisket for the Saturday evening meal, the rest of the "fixings" will be provided by SBBA. Friday evening will be a Bring-Your-Own-Meat potluck, with the Residents of Burro Mt. Please only bring a dish for 4-6 people so we don't have too much food. Plan to bring your own lunches, snacks, and beverages.

COST

Meeting fee:

\$15 per person (to help cover the cost of liability insurance)

Camping fees:

Full hookup - \$17.50 plus tax per night

No hookup - \$10.00 plus tax per night

No additional cost for horses, but there are no facilities, so bring portable corrals or plan to tie to your trailer. * Please bring water for your horses *

Rooms: The rooms at Burro Mt. are already reserved. Contact Rebecca Chandos to inquire about cancellations, etc. Motel rooms are available in Silver City.

BRINGING HORSES? READ ON...

- There is no additional cost for bringing horses, but there are no horse facilities. Plan to bring portable corrals or plan to tie to your trailer.
- Stock water is limited so please bring as much as you are able.
- This is not a horse facility, so we need to clean up our manure. A trailer will be available for manure disposal.
- Trail footing is pretty good. With hard footed horses, shoes are optional.
- New Mexico Livestock Board requires a current Coggins test & a Health Certificate for horses entering the state.
- Stallions will not be allowed due to insurance regulations.
