Spanish Barb Horse Association will be at the 2nd Annual Southern Arizona Horse Expo in Tucson, AZ, on January 15th and 16th

Silver City, New Mexico – The Spanish Barb Horses Association's (SBHA) is dedicated to the preservation, perpetuation and promotion of the rare Spanish Barb Horse. At the 2nd Annual Southern Arizona Horse Expo SBHA will be sharing a booth with the Expo's manager Clay Harper. The Expo will be held on January 15th and 16th at the University of Arizona's (U of A) Farm Arena, on Campbell Avenue between Roger and Limberlost in Tucson, AZ.

Come by the SBHA booth to learn about SBHA, these rare horses and meet members of SBHA. Meet Silke Schneider author of *Arizona's Spanish Barbs* and a breeder of Spanish Barbs. Marjorie Dixon of the Dragoon Mountain Ranch and Heidi Collins of Dripping Springs will be at the booth to talk about their Colonial Spanish Barbs. Several Spanish Barb Horse owners will be at the booth to introduce you to this wonderful rare breed of horse.

See Rosemary Gordon Pánuco presenting her Spanish Barb, Article VII better known as Leo. Leo will demonstrate jumping in Rosemary's talk on "How To Teach A Horse To Jump." Leo has won many championships in Dressage and the Hunter Jumper Arena. In 2010, he won the THJA's year end Champion Modified Childrens/Adult Amateur Hunter, the Champion at the Tucson Fall Preview in the Pre-Childrens/Adult Amateur Hunter Division and Reserve Champion Fall Festival. Leo also has carried a physically impaired adult rider to his dream of riding in a clinic with Olympic Rider Gwen Stockebrand!

The Arizona Horse Project will have a petition to have the Colonial Spanish Horse named as the Arizona State Heritage Horse at the SBHA booth. Everyone signing the petition will

receive a raffle ticket for framed photos of beautiful Spanish Barb Mares donated by Maureen Kirk-Detberner of FastWinn Photography.
